VII. Instructions for Completing Application

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call 248-625-8111, both **job location** and **permit number** will be required for inspection request.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED.**
